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In G.O.Ms.No.318, IIM&FW(M2) Dept., Dt.29-9-2000, Government have constituted a new committee under the Chairmanship of Justice G.Radhakrishna Rao, retired judge, High Court of A.P., and with (9) others as Members to process the applications received from the interested parties for establishment of Para-Medical Institutions and submit its recommendations to Government for taking necessary action.

2. The Selection Committee, Para Medical Institutions, Hyderabad has sent inspection officers for inspection of the Societies and based on Inspection reports, the matter was placed before the said Committee at its meetings held on 13-9-2002 and on 1-11-2002. The Chairman, Selection Committee, has forwarded the recommendations of the Selection Committee, to Government for establishment of Nursing Schools in Private Sector. The Chairman, Selection Committee, Para Medical Institutions has requested the Government to take necessary action for issue of essentiality certificates to the above Societies for establishment of respective Training Schools/Institutions as recommended by the Committee with the intake capacities mentioned therein subject to satisfying the rules and other conditions.
3. Government after careful examination of the matter have accepted the above recommendations of the Chairman, Selection Committee, Para Medical Institutions, A.P Secretariat Buildings, Hyderabad and the details of recommended cases i.e. name of the course, intake capacity recommended and the name of the Educational Society and its Address to which Essentiality Certificates are issued, are shown in the Annexure -I to this Memo. The Educational Societies concerned are therefore requested to fulfill the conditions stipulated for establishment of the School of Nursing course as indicated in Annexure II to this Memo.
4. The President A.P. Nursing and Midwifery Council and Director of Medical Education, Hyderabad is informed that the issue of prescribing annual registration fee, instead of payment of security deposit for establishment of Nursing Schools is under examination of the Government. She is, therefore, requested to conduct the inspection of the proposed School of Nursing as per the procedure and furnish detailed information as per the Annexure prescribed by the Government within the time specified.

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positively, on the condition that proposed Nursing School should pay the annual registration fee or any other fee to be prescribed by Government from time to time. An undertaking from ~~the~~ Educational Agency may be obtained, and furnished to that effect.

ANNEXURE-II

THE CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF
- NURSING SCHOOL

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A. There will be a surprise quarterly check of all these institutions by an Officer deputed by the President, Andhra Pradesh Nurses and Midwifery council and the Director of Medical Education to ensure that :

- i) the institution is being run regularly with the required physical and clinical facilities;
- ii) the required teaching staff with the necessary qualifications as per the Indian Nursing Council Regulations are employed to educate and train the students properly in accordance with the prescribed syllabus ;
- iii) the institution is being run efficiently in the best interests of the students ;
- iv) the procedures prescribed for the selection and admission of students are scrupulously followed including the selection of students from local areas and observing the rules of reservation;
- v) the admissions are made only for the year specified by the President, A.P., Nurses and Midwifery and the DME in his order granting provisional affiliation;
- vi) the location of the institution is not shifted from the location indicated in the application or shown to the inspecting team without written prior permission from the Government.
- vii) the number of students admitted do not exceed the number of students permitted for annual admission;
- viii) the fees collected by whatsoever name called either for free seats or for management seats do not exceed the limits specified in the Government orders or Indian Nursing Council Regulations;
- ix) the students hostels, wherever provided are adequately furnished with appropriate areas for their comfortable stay and provision is made for their indoor or outdoor games.

B. The Educational Agency should not issue any advertisement calling for applications for admission into the college or make any admissions till after President, A.P. Nurses and Midwifery council and DME. grants his permission and provisional affiliation to it to establish the School and save in accordance with the rules governing the issue of such advertisement and making the selections.

C. Whenever the Government or the A.P. Nurses and Midwifery council and DME, forms the opinion that the Educational agency is not running the college in the best interests of the students, it will cancel the permission after giving 15 days notice to the Educational Agency to show cause, against the proposed cancellation and pass appropriate orders after considering the explanation, if any, offered by the Agency against the show cause notice.

D. The Educational Society has to fulfill the above conditions within 15 days from the date of issue of this memo and send intimation to the President, Andhra Pradesh Nurses & Midwifery Council & Director of Medical Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad that all the above conditions have been fulfilled. The President Andhra Pradesh Nurses & Midwifery council & Director of Medical Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad on receipt of the compliance report in respect of the above conditions from the applicant Institution will depute an Officer to satisfy himself and submit report that all the aforesaid requirements have been fulfilled and recommend the number of students who can be admitted in the School of Nursing. Only after a satisfactory report is received, permission will be granted to establish a School of Nursing, subject to payment of annual registration fee or other fee as may be prescribed by Government.
