Private MPHWF training institutions Association, Vijayawada – Request to inform the fees structure, duration of the MPHWF training course and the eligibility criteria to the Commissioner, Social Welfare, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad for sanction of post-metric scholarships to the trainees by the Social Welfare Department – Information submitted –Request for sanction of post-metric scholarships to the candidates who are undergoing 2 years course of MPHWF training course - Regarding.

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With reference to the G.O 1st cited, I am to inform that previously the Govt. have issued policy and regulation of grant of permission and admission rules for the MPHWF training course vide G.O.Ms.No.314, HM&FW (D2) Dept., dt:16.08.1997 as follows:

- 1.The eligibility criteria to the MPHWF training course is SSC pass.
- 2.The duration of MPHWF training course period is 1 ½ year.
- 3.The maximum fees is Rs.500/- per month per head for free seats.
- 4.The minimum age for admission to the MPHWF training course is 15 years.
- 5.The rule of reservation should be followed in the admissions of MPHWF training course.
- 6.The Selection Committee consisting of the following
 - 1.Joint Collector of the district – Chairman
 - 2.District Medical & Health Officer of the district – Member Convenor
 - 3.Superintendent of the district headquarters Hospital – Member
 - 4.Deputy Director, Social Welfare – Member
 - 5.Principal of the concerned training institution – Member

Further, the Govt. have issued a new rules for admission of MPHWF training course vide G.O.Ms.No.99, HM&FW (K2) Dept., dt:26.05.2014 in place of old rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.314, HM&FW (D2) Dept., dt:16.08.1997 as follows:

- 1.The eligibility criteria to the MPHWF training course is increased from SSC pass to Intermediate pass (10+2).
- 2.The duration of MPHWF training course period is also increased from 1 ½ years to 2 years.
- 3.The maximum fees also increased from Rs.500/- to Rs.1000/- per month per head for free seats only.
- 4.The minimum age for admission to the MPHWF training course is also increased from 15 years to 17 years as on 31st December of the admission year and the upper age limit is 30 years and the upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of SC/ST/BC as per rules in force.
- 5.The rule of reservation should be followed in the admissions of MPHWF training course.
- 6.The Selection Committee consisting of the following:

- 1.Joint Collector of the district – Chairman
- 2.District Medical & Health Officer of the district – Member Convenor
- 3.Superintendent of the district headquarters Hospital – Member
- 4.Principal of the concerned training institution – Member

Recently, admissions for the 2 years course of MPHWF training course for the academic year 2015-16 have been done by the selection committee and allotted to the MPHWF training course institutions with the qualification of Intermediate pass and the duration of training is 2 years for MPHWF training course.

I therefore request you consider for sanction of scholarships to the candidates who have been selected for MPHWF training course with the qualification of Intermediate pass and duration of training course is 2 years & undergoing MPHWF Training course in the MPHWF training institutions in the A.P. State in the convenor quota i.e., in free seats since as per existing rules 60% of seats for convenor quota & 40% seats for management quota in the private MPHWF Training Institutions and 100% seats are convenor quota in Govt. MPHWF Training institutions and Grant-in-aid MPHWF Training institutions.
