A kind attention of the subject to all the Officials in the addressed entry, it is to inform that INC initiated a project on "Live Register of Nurses" in the Digital format through the Nurses Registration and Tracking System software developed by NIC and hosted on the web since September, 2017. This project is focused on enrolment of Nurses with unique ID called NUID (Nurses Unique ID) issued by INC through NRTS.

As per NRTS, every Nurse will get,

- Free Enrolment of Nurses- Hassel free registrations and Linked with Aadhar- Biometric Authentication
- Simplified Registration and has integrated uniform system across the county
- Candidates getting NUID Card will get the incentive of 30 hours of CNE for the first time
- Empower Nurses with National Unique Identity Number (NUID)
- Facilitate for effective manpower planning for policy makers at State and National Level.
- Uniform issuance of Nurse Passbook comprising of complete history of Nurse Midwifery.
- Renewal of licence once in five years linked with 150 hours of Continuing Nursing Education (CNE).

It is to pleasure to state that the enrolment process handled successfully by the Registrar, AP Nurses & Midwives Council with the support of manpower & equipment provided by INC since 3 years through vast communication with all the Government & Private Sectors in sort of Letters/Circulars/Notices/Telephone etc.

In this sequence, INC organized a scheduled zoom meeting with Registrars of State Nursing Councils, NIC Officials & M/s. Fino Pay Tech Pvt. Ltd., on 03.06.2020 for an update on NRTS.

As per the records of Registered Nurses in the State of Andhra Pradesh, only 30% of Nurses have enrolled in NRTS since 2017. In this regard, INC suggested APNMC to inform to all the Registered Nurses who have not yet enrolled in NUID have to apply self online on priority in INC-NRTS website (nrts.indiannursingcouncil.gov.in) with free of cost on or before 16th August, 2020 Otherwise fees of Rs. 1000/- shall be charged for enrolment.

The self enrolled (through online) candidates will receive SMS (generated by NIC) mentioned to visit O/o APNMC for Biometric & Photo Scan for completing the enrolment application.

In view of the above, all the Officials addressed below are hereby requested to pass on the mandate enrolment of NUID by all the Registered Nurses & Registered Midwives under your control who have not yet enrolled so far. (nrts.indiannursingcouncil.gov.in).
